Your child will NOT be allowed to leave the building during camp hours  
including going to the party store next door.

We expect ALL children to display appropriate behavior. If your child is a  
problem and causes disruption in a class, he or she will not be allowed to  
attend that class. This is also for the safety of all.

THE ENCLOSED MEDICAL FORM MUST BE COMPLETED AND  
RETURNED WITH YOUR CHILD THE FIRST DAY HE OR SHE  
ATTENDS CLASS. PLEASE MAKE CERTAIN THERE IS AN  
EMERGENCY NUMBER WHERE SOMEONE MAY ACTUALLY BE  
ABLE TO ANSWER. Yes, the notarized form must actually be notarized.  
BE SPECIFIC ABOUT ANY SPECIAL NEEDS YOUR CHILD MAY  
HAVE. IT IS BETTER FOR US TO BE INFORMED. Do not assume we  
will not notice special needs- inform us so we may be better teachers. If you  
child has difficult behavioral issues, we will need to evaluate our ability to  
accommodate- this is a volunteer program for instructors.
