We do not want any child to fall off the stage and you, the parents, can prevent this by being actively involved.

Additionally, the munchkins, particularly, need guidance in following directions and paying attention.

Children cannot be needing to be picked up, tickling, running, hiding in the curtains, etc. while on stage. Each rehearsal is a practice for what they need to do when on stage during the actual performance.

When you are watching the show, you will not want your child to be noticeably doing the wrong thing!
